Group Discussion Questions

Please read *Hebrews 2:17-18 & 4:14-16* – How should Jesus' 'God-man' nature help Christians...

... appreciate God the Son's taking on of flesh to be our perfect Intercessor?

... approach Him without fear or intimidation when we need His forgiveness?

... approach Him for help in our weaknesses, fears and failures?

... anticipate the 'judgment seat of Christ' with joyful anticipation?

While retaining all of His attributes of deity, God the Son *emptied* Himself of all majestic glory, veiling His divinity in the body of Jesus Christ *(Philippians 2:5-7)*.

When we minister to others, what obvious virtue about us Christians does this display?

What *personal glories* should Christians *empty* themselves of, to be more like Christ when they are seeking to serve the Lord?

How is this *humbling of ourselves (1 Peter 5:5-6)* part of the sanctification process we are undergoing as believers?

In a world that disgraces His holy Name, what can believers do to uphold and honor the Name of Jesus at home, school, work and the community? *(Exodus 20:7)*

Knowing that Jesus is coming again, only as Lord of lords and King of kings next time, how should believers live? (2 Peter 3:11-14)
