Better Gifts For A Good & Perfect Christmas

Christmas gift-giving is a tremendous joy for some, but a dreadful task for others. If you are a Christian with the spiritual gift of *giving* (*Romans 12:8*), it comes naturally to you and Christmas is time for your spiritual enablement from the Holy Spirit to shine like that Bethlehem star. If you have some other primary spiritual gift, *giving* probably isn't as much fun for you, but like those other six *spiritual gifts* (*Romans 12:6-8*), you are obliged to do it, even if giving doesn't happen to be your specialty.

The LORD God loves to give and is really, really good at it! As the theme verse for our 2019 Christmas series affirms – if you are truly a born-again child of God (*John 3:5-7*), you have a Heavenly Father Who loves to give you *gifts* that are exactly what He knows you need – gifts that are *good* and *perfect* like Him. Usually, the gifts He sends us aren't exactly what we remember asking for on that *gifts list* we gave Him. That's because His heavenly presents are always better than we *asked or imagined* (*Ephesians 2:20-21*).

This Christmas season, let's think about this biblical premise as we study those verses from *James*. Amidst the holiday festivities, let's seek a deeper appreciation of the many *good and perfect* gifts God gave to the world that original Christmas so long ago. And let's prayerfully think through how we, God's children, can give *good and perfect* gifts to our *good and perfect* heavenly Father this year.

Sunday, December 29 th -	'Good & Perfect Gift Preservation' (James 1:18b) (gifts that get better and better with use in Christian service)

Tuesday, December 31st - CBF Church Family New Year's Eve Worship & Fellowship (7 pm)

What? God's good & perfect selection

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, just as <u>He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world..."</u>

Who? God's good, perfect Savior

"...but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot, <u>He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world</u>, but was manifested in these last times for you who through Him believe in God..."

When? God's good & perfect schedule

"But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the_adoption as sons..."

Why? God's good & perfect salvation

"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise... but is longsuffering toward <u>us</u>, <u>not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.</u>"

How? God's good & perfect 'sign'

"I see Him (Messiah), but not now; <u>I behold Him, but not near</u>; <u>A Star shall come</u> out of Jacob; <u>A scepter shall rise out of Israel</u>..."

Our Good & Perfect Gifts for Our Father

If you are not absolutely sure you have been *born again* through repentance and saving faith in the Lord Jesus' Christ's cross-work (*not His cradle rest*), you are not a child of God.

- ♥ You are not good and perfect enough to go to heaven as you are.
- ♥ You must receive the good and perfect Gift of Jesus by inviting Him into your life.
- ♦ In order to not perish, give yourself to the Lord today; He will gladly receive you!

If you have received God's Gift of everlasting life, wrapped up in the divine Person of the Lord Jesus Christ (*1 John 5:11-13*):

- ♥ You are obliged to let the light of His presence shine within you, through you to others, and to God in worship (*Matthew 5:11-12, Philippians 2:14-16*).
